Golf Course Usage Rules and Guidelines
Updated 2018

Welcome to another season of golf. We are pleased to publish an updated **2018 Golf Course Usage Rules and Guidelines** as follows:

Residents must be in possession of their Villages of Rosedale Inc. Clubhouse Identification Card while on the golf course and must show it to a marshal when requested to do so. (A photocopy of the id card is acceptable.)

1. Use of the course shall be limited to residents and their guests. Residents are at all times responsible for their guests. Residents are fully responsible for ensuring that their guests are aware of, and obey, all rules and regulations respecting use of the golf course. **Each golfing group must include one resident who is in possession of their Villages of Rosedale Inc. Clubhouse Identification Card.** The resident does not have to play. Note: Maximum 4 players per group and 5 in total where the resident is not a player.
2. The use of a tee is mandatory on all tee decks. Players are required to replace divots on tee-decks, if possible, or fill divot holes with sand/seed mixture supplied at each deck. Players are also required to replace divots on fairways.
3. Everyone must play with their own set of golf clubs.
4. Practice golf, that is, hitting several balls from the same location is prohibited anywhere on the course. Please use the Hitting Cage for that purpose.
5. Pull-carts are not to be drawn over the tee decks, greens or front aprons.
6. Players are required to fix all damages caused to the course including divots, ball marks etc using the proper tools.
7. Players may use privately owned, electric powered golf carts. Gas carts are not permitted.
 - a. Golf Carts should remain on cart paths but the 90-degree rule is allowed.
 - b. If medical reasons necessitate special allowances, the Accessible Permit stickers and poles will be issued upon presentation of a valid Permanent (Blue) Accessible Parking Permit (APP), or the presentation of a suitable document from a certified medical professional. In any case these powered golf carts must be kept at least 10 feet from greens and tee areas.
 - c. Electric or pull carts are not allowed on the front aprons.
 - d. Cart drivers must be at least 16 years or older.
 - e. The cart driver and owner of the golf cart will be held fully responsible for any and all damages to the golf course caused by misuse of the golf cart. The cart driver and owner of the golf cart shall reimburse Villages of Rosedale Inc. for any and all damages the Villages of Rosedale Inc. may sustain, by reason of misuse while on the golf course, intentionally or not.
 - f. Please refer to community rules regarding golf cart usage throughout the Villages
8. Golfers must obey the "No electric power carts today due to wet conditions" sign when it is in place.
9. The golf course holes must be played in numerical sequence, starting at the Number #1 tee through to the last green (Number #9) which is located to the southeast of the clubhouse behind Condominium Building B. Access to the course shall be only at the entrance located directly across from the clubhouse which is the Number #1 tee located to the northeast of the clubhouse behind Condominium Building C, or by using the designated cart paths.
10. Where the golf course is in close proximity to resident's homes, the boundary of the course is marked with white stakes. These white stakes form out of bounds stakes as defined in The Rules of Golf. A ball must not be played from out of bounds. A player, having hit their ball out of bounds, must replay the shot from the original position having counted the original shot plus one penalty stroke.
11. Proper attire is required. NO cut offs, bathing suits, tank tops, halter tops, or promotional tee shirts are considered appropriate for the golf course. Preferred attire includes collared shirts, full-length pants, golf shorts and golf skirts. Either soft spiked or soft-soled shoes must be worn on the course (i.e. no metal spikes).

12. **Pets are not allowed on the golf course including the cart paths at any time.**
13. Any course hazards/deficiencies are to be referred to a Golf Committee Member who will refer them to The Villages of Rosedale Inc. for review and communication to the maintenance division.
14. **RECREATIONAL WALKING, JOGGING OR BICYCLING IS NOT PERMITTED ON THE GOLF COURSE AT ANYTIME.**
15. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the golf course.
16. All children 16 years and under who are golfing, must at all times while on the course, be accompanied by a **RESIDENT** adult, who is in possession of their Villages of Rosedale Inc. Clubhouse Identification Card. All children 16 years and under who are not golfing are not permitted on the course at any time. Children 11 and under are required to have Golf Knowledge to play this course.
17. Always play without delay and keep up with the group in front. Invite faster groups to play through.
18. Reservations of the Golf Course for exclusive tournament play or other special events with proposed management outside of the Golf Committee, must apply to the Golf Committee Chair in writing for permission at least 60 days in advance of the requested play date(s). Such requests must describe the rationale of the proposed event, the targeted participants, the date(s) and time(s) desired, and any special event support requirements. The Villages' Board of Directors reserves the right in its sole and absolute discretion to approve or reject such application. Any approval or rejection from the Villages' Board of Directors will be evidenced in writing. Depending on the nature of the event, the Villages' Board of Directors may make its approval or rejection on any number of criteria including the possibility of the payment of a special event fee.
19. At the discretion of the Golf Committee, marshals will patrol the golf course from time to time to ensure that rules are being followed. These marshals shall be officially appointed by the Golf Committee and shall carry badges or other identification identifying them in these official roles.
20. GOLF CANADA RULES should be recognized and followed on the golf course.
21. Access to the golf course is at the discretion and sole risk of whomever chooses to enter upon it. Neither the Rosedale Golf Committee, the Villages of Rosedale Inc. (*or its affiliated Rosedale Corporations, Coldwell Banker Real Estate Management Professionals, sub-contractors, staff, etc.*) assume any risk/liability whatsoever for/to any property or person(s) accessing the golf course for golf play or otherwise.
22. Leagues: Golf League play is permitted on Fridays between 9:30 and 11:30 for ladies. Leagues are open to residents only, please contact the league organizers directly for information. Leagues are run by private residents. **The Rosedale Golf Committee supports these leagues but is not responsible for how they operate. The Villages of Rosedale Inc is not responsible for the activities of these leagues and how they operate.**
23. Use of Hitting Cage:
 - a. Anyone under the age of 16 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult resident over the age of 21 at all times.
 - b. Only one (1) person is allowed in each cage at any time.
 - c. Hitting time is limited to 30 minutes if other residents are waiting in line to hit.
 - d. There shall be no practice hitting before 7am and after 7:00 pm.
 - e. Cages are restricted to the use of golf balls or practice golf balls only.

All other rules applying to the golf course will govern the use of the hitting cages.
